ArtSmart Classes Ages 4-5

The ArtSmart Classes are designed to be fun, creative and lively. Your children will utilize fine motor skills, intuitive thinking and creative problem solving.

Week 1: June 5-9 Trees, Trees, Trees

Wander through forests of creative ideas in a week of art inspired by trees. Draw, paint & sculpt trees using water color, tempera & marker. Discover the variety of leaf shapes & colors. We'll view real trees, photographs of trees & inventive drawings of trees to widen our inspiration.

Week 1: June 5-9 Birds and Worms

Birds of a feather create together. Paint, draw & create real & imaginary winged creatures.

Week 1: June 5-9 I Love My Cat

Meow & purr through a week of artistic felines & their friends. Our master painter will demonstrate & teach how to create realistic & cartoon kitties.

Week 2: June 12-16 Colors Galore!

Enjoy using splashes of color to create fabulous masterpieces. What color would you choose to represent each member of your family? What color describes your mood? Spin the color wheel to explore what new colors we can invent through mixing & tinting. Enjoy multi-media creating with paint, paper & fabrics!

Week 2: June 12-16 Mouse Paint

This week artists will mix unique paint colors to use on their masterpieces. Make a color wheel. Paint & sculpt little creatures in unusual color combos.

Week 2: June 12-16 Polka Dots and Plaids

Let's explore patterns & shapes. Put shapes together into a pattern to make a modern design. Paint, draw & make collages with creative designs.

Week 3: June 19-23 Animal Adventure

Discover the amazing world of animals in art. Create colorful works of art inspired by the Animal Kingdom. A wild adventure with sculpting, drawing, painting, markers... & more!

Week 3: June 19-23 Artsy Accessories

Craft Super Hero cuffs, crazy shaped necklaces, gold foiled & animal faced brooches. Artists will use a wide variety of materials in this fun filled class.

Week 3: June 19-23 Fruity Art

Artists will make prints with cut fruit & veggies. Discover the creative design of seeds. Draw, paint & sculpt your favorite tasty treat.

Week 4: June 26-30 Shape of the Family

Who's in your family? Do they have funny faces? What shapes would you use to draw each one? Learn to show expressions of a face. Try your hand at realistic portraits & funny caricatures. Join us in drawing, painting & sculpting those near to our heart.

Week 4: June 26-30 Colorful Textures

Inspired by the art of Max Ernst & Van Gogh, students discover frottage as they create imaginary landscapes, & the many moods of color. Students will also create futuristic works of art, portraits & natural textures using paint, fabric, drawing & sculpture.

Week 4: June 26-30 Sea Creatures

Dive into a week of fish, octopus & seaweed. Enjoy painting, drawing & crafting fascinating creature of the sea.

Week 5: July 10-14 Mystery Drawing

Have you ever drawn with your eyes closed? The projects for this week are a big surprise! Become an artistic Sherlock Holmes, uncovering clues & creating mysterious art.

Week 5: July 10-14 Artsy and Over the Top Fun

Create sea creatures, blossoms, stained "glass" windows & masks in this crazy mixed up class. Artists will use paint, glue, tape & bleeding tissue paper.

Week 5: July 10-14 Mosaics

Make tiles, seeds, beads & fabrics into mosaic masterpieces. Incorporate painted pieces into for a beautiful finished product.

Week 6: July 17-21 Starchy Yarn Lines

Come "string along" with us as we make sculpture out of yarn that's stiffened with starch (great sculpting material!). We will explore various ways of using this long fuzzy "starchy yarn" to make art. We will finish by adding a splash of paint & drawings to our creations.

Week 6: July 17-21 All Kinds of Printing

Discover Sun prints, gadget printing & scratch foam printing. Design papers on which to print artist's unique designs.

Week 6: July 17-21 Mystery Week

A week of surprise art projects! Each day students will guess the artist of the day & create a masterpiece inspired by that artist.

Week 7: July 24-28 Play with Clay

Take a ball of clay & start creating. What shape will emerge as you play with the mud? We will make a variety of sculptures, vessels & slab pieces, even alien heads of clay & junk. Add finishing touches of decoration, paint & glaze to your masterpieces.

Week 7: July 24-28 Raindrops and Rainbows

How would a picture change with the weather? Artists will create rainbows & showers with paint, markers & clay.

Week 7: July 24-28 Outer Space

Draw, paint & sculpt stars, moons planets & rocket ships. Chalk a few aliens & constellations into your outer space creations.

Week 8: July 31 - August 4 Doodle & Splat

Doodle around & splat a bit to create crazy artworks. Doodle some bugs & splat some trees, sculpt a crazy face & more!

Week 8: July 31 - August 4 Simply Unique

Make a splash in Monet's lily pond, create colorful butterflies, craft a cut paper swan & more in this mish-mash of unique art projects.

Week 8: July 31 - August 4 Deep in the Jungle

Spend a week exploring animals & plants that exists deep into the forests of the world. It will be a wild week with wild animals.

Week 9: Aug. 7-11 Colorful Creative Collage

Cut, paint, print & paste all week to create fabulous collage masterpieces. Students will use paper, cloth, string & doo-dads.

Week 9: Aug. 7-11 Collage For Kids

Cut & paste creative colorful collages using magazines, cloth, painted art works as well as buttons, yarns & beads.

Week 9: Aug. 7-11 Sticker Stories

Create little stories on mini books starting with a colorful sticker. Design your very own stickers - small & large - with paint, markers, & chalk.

Imagination Classes Ages 6-12

Each day, artists will spark their imaginations while creating unique art projects. Week-long classes have a central theme allowing children to explore a range of art materials & techniques.

Week 1: June 5-9 Food Art

Gobble up a week of delectable art creations. Create a food sculpture, paint pictures for a mini restaurant, design a picnic cloth & more.

Week 1: June 5-9 Packing for Fun

Style a suitcase, a luggage tag, vacation clothes then paint a picture of your dream vacation spot. Enjoy a week full of paint, drawing & 3D creating.

Week 1: June 5-9 Cartooning

Draw cartoon characters & turn them into a comic strip. Finish off your artwork with coloring, paint & markers.

Week 2: June 12-16 Zoo Safari

Roar, chirp & growl your way through animal inspired art. Paint, draw & sculpt wild animals & zoo dwellers while discovering the creative patterns of animal skins, footprints & feathers.

Week 2: June 12-16 Dreams

Dreams come to life as children artistically convey their visions in 2D & 3D projects.

Week 2: June 12-16 Vacation Imagination

Draw, paint & sculpt all the fabulous places the children hope to see on vacation.

Week 3: June 19-23 Summer Survivors

Feeling adventurous? Become an artistic survivalist & design a deserted island, put up a campsite, build a boat & draw a treasure map. Paint, sketch & sculpt as if your life depended upon it!

Week 3: June 19-23 Clay & Sculpture

Introduction to working with clay through hands-on training. Students will learn some basic clay, pottery, & sculpture concepts using different tools & hand-building techniques, creating projects.

Week 3: June 19-23 Bugs and Butterflies

We will draw, paint & sculpt insects & their environments.

Week 4: June 26-June 30 Hues of Summer

Experiment with mixing, tinting & shading colors. Make a 2017-18 school calendar, color the seasons, design patchwork quilt & a clubhouse using your signature hues, & blend music with colors.

Week 4: June 19-23 Clay & Sculpture

Introduction to working with clay through hands-on training. Students will learn some basic clay, pottery, & sculpture concepts using different tools & hand-building techniques, creating projects.

Week 4: June 26-June 30 To Infinity... and Beyond!

Become astronauts creating masterpieces inspired by outer space. Paint, draw & build rockets, solar systems & space creatures.

Week 5: July 10-14 Monsters in Mythology

Journey into the mythological world of monsters. We will let our imaginations run rampant as we create a variety of monsters in paint, sculpture, drawing & 3D projects.

Week 5: July 10-14 Musical Dreams

Inspired by music & by the dreamy artwork of Miro, Picasso & Kandinsky we will sketch, paint, & create mosaics & more.

Week 5: July 10-14 Musical Instruments

Let's create some music together! Design rain sticks, tambourines, maracas & more in this jazzy class.

Week 6: July 17-21 3D Class

There's nothing flat about this week of eye-popping creativity. It is a class of sculpture, but we will go beyond the clay. We will sculpt in clay, papier-mâché, cloth, & create a junky masterpiece with recycled materials!

Week 6: July 17-21 You Are What You Wear

Do you have a flair for fashion? Join us in a week creating artistic wearables, designing fabric & more.

Week 6: July 17-21 Monster Trucks and Sports Cars

Vroom, Vroom, Vroom... Paint, draw & build vehicles of all shapes & sizes.

Week 7: July 24-28 Around the World in 5 Days

Travel the globe making origami, clay creations, drawings & paintings of majestic, worldly sights. We will be inspired by other cultures & learn fascinating facts while creating.

Week 7: July 24-28 Fashion Vibes

Fashionistas will enjoy figure drawing & creating their own fashion accessories like pins & fans.

Week 7: July 24-28 Exploring Texas

Travel the great state in artistic style. Make a splash sculpting Gulf fish, the Alamo, paint bluebonnets, Texas Piney Woods & more.

Week 8: July 31-Aug 4 Mixed Media

We will do painting & drawing, hands-on projects, collage, sumi drawing... & more.
